PGME NOTES:

1. The EPA list has been reduced in number since Jan 29th CBD meeting with Med Onc. This occurred as a result of discussions with other Med Onc physicians. Further changes were made to the EPAs by the RC committee on June 1st.
2. As anticipated, changes were made to the EPAs for stages TTD and FOD. We also anticipate changes to the COD and TTP EPAs as these stages are mapped to the curriculum.
3. Current priorities for EPA implementation in the 2016-17 academic year include TTD-2; FOD-1, 2 and 7; COD-1, 2 and 9; and TTP-1.
